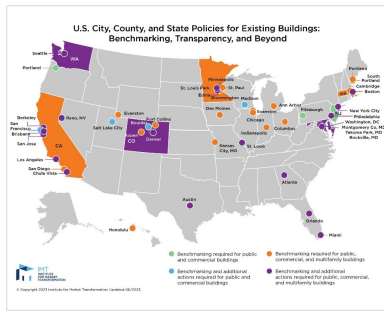

From the State of Michigan

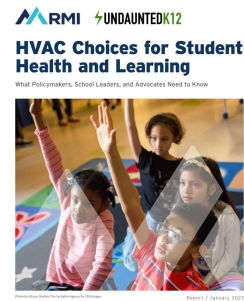
