Neutral Tone on Brands:

It's acceptable to highlight innovative technologies or solutions. However, avoid promoting specific brands unless they are the sole provider of a particular technology. Maintain a balanced perspective.

Structure:

Start with a compelling headline and introduction to draw readers in. Use subheadings, bullet points, and concise paragraphs for readability. Conclude with actionable takeaways, questions for readers to consider, or a call to action.

Acknowledgment:

Include a brief acknowledgement for anyone else who contributed significantly to this post or from whose work the content was largely, or in part, derived.

Submission Process

- File Format: Submit your blog as a Word document or Google Doc.
- **Editing:** The Seattle 2030 District reserves the right to make minor edits for clarity, grammar, and style while maintaining the original message.
- **Contact Information:** Include your name, photo or headshot, organization (if applicable), and a short bio (50 words max).
